What do I need to access the service?

You will need a referral from your GP to access the service. Our friendly team will discuss the details with you when you make an appointment.

Is a hearing test safe for my child?

Yes, our hearing tests are entirely safe for your child.

We know it can be daunting for parents and caregivers, so our specialist NextSense paediatric audiologists will be with you every step of the way. Experienced working with newborns and young people onwards—they'll ensure a comfortable environment for your child.

What hearing tests are available?

NextSense offers a full range of hearing tests, including:

- Behavioural observation audiometry
- Visual reinforcement audiometry
- Play audiometry
- Pure tone audiometry (PTA)
- Auditory brainstem response (ABR) testing
- Auditory steady state response (ASSR) testing
- Otoacoustic emission testing
- Tympanometry
- Speech discrimination tests
- Tests for auditory processing disorders.
